IMPACT SUMMARY 2024

Access and engagement for people experiencing vehicular homelessness.



THE NEED

According to the 2024 Greater LA Homeless Count, people experiencing vehicular homelessness comprise over 44%—totaling more than 23,000 adults and children on any given night—of our county's unsheltered population. This is the largest subgroup of people living on the streets throughout LA County.

While the 2024 data shows progress in reducing homelessness overall, there remains a significant need for access and engagement for households living in cars, vans, and RVs. Safe parking programs enhance the region's homelessness response by offering stability and extending services to many individuals and families with nowhere else to turn.

Safe Parking LA served 60 Veterans, plus their household members and pets, through our **Veterans Safe Parking Program** at the West LA VA Campus in 2024.

One of them was Ben, a former U.S. Army combat infantryman, who exited the program into permanent housing.

ANGELA

Angela, 52, spent most of her career supporting others. She worked in education and in homeless services, providing care to others even as her own housing became unstable.

After living with an elderly client as a caregiver for several years, Angela moved in with her uncle and found work supporting community health as a vaccine ambassador. But when her uncle became ill and had to relocate, Angela had no choice but to move out. Without access to affordable housing, she began living in her car.

Angela continued working throughout this period, parking near office buildings at night and paying for temporary rooms when she could. In early 2024, the program where she worked was shut down due to funding cuts. That's when she found Safe Parking LA.

At SPLA, Angela accessed a safe place to sleep, hygiene facilities, and reliable case management. She worked closely with her case manager, Monica, who referred her to a housing navigator at PATH. Within a few months, Angela moved into an apartment in Whittier.

Angela also found new employment—first tutoring, then accepting a higher-paying job with LA County Probation supporting young adults impacted by the justice system. **Today, Angela is housed, employed, and fulfilling her passion for education and service.**
